

Directions to Tucker Creek Farm

From Thunder Bay head south on Highway 61 towards the US border. We are located at 3020, Hwy 61 just past the Thunder Bay Correctional Centre. We are the first driveway on the right hand side next to Recool Canada Ltd., but still on Highway 61. If you have reached DeBruin Nursery , you just missed the driveway.(we are directly across the highway from DeBruin Nursery)

From the US border, heading north on Highway 61 towards the city of Thunder Bay we are approximately 45 kms. from the border. We are the first driveway on the left across the hwy from DeBruin's Nursery. If you see the Thunder Bay Correctional Centre , you have gone too far.

Please park in the designated parking area. We ask that you pick up after your dogs and put the bags in the garbage cans provided. Be sure to bring clothing and things for the weather such as rubber boots and raingear, baggies for poop and scoop, shade and water for your dogs. There are no trees near the arenas.

There will be either a luncheon or concession for the trials. BBQ, snacks and refreshments will be available for sale.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

Foreign born dogs require an ERN to earn CKC titles. This ERN MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event WILL result in the cancellation of any wins, awards, or scores. To obtain an ERN, send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example, AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN. With the above, include a cheque, money order or MC/VISA number in the amount of \$58.85 Canadian payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. FAXED requests will be accepted.

Performance Event Number (PEN)

A PEN allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. Events include obedience trials, tracking tests, herding trials, draft dog tests, agility, lure coursing, earthdog tests, hunt tests, working certificate tests and pointing field dog tests. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met: dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC, dog for some reason is not eligible for CKC registration, dog must be spayed or neutered, dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (not necessary for ILP dogs), dog cannot be on the CKC miscellaneous class list, and in the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC ILP number. A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a listed dog. Events may only be entered after PEN has been issued.

I further agree that I will hold the CKC, its officers, directors, agents and members, the trial giving club (Thunder Bay Cocker Spaniel Club), its officers, directors, agents and members and the owners of the facility (Tanya Wheeler of Tucker Creek Farm) and the stock, harmless and defend them from any and all liability for any injury, claim, damage or loss, of whatever kind or nature, whether to person or property, caused at or near this event, whether directly or indirectly, by or to me or any dog I have entered in or brought to this event. I agree to indemnify the CKC, its officers, directors, agents and members, the trial giving club, its officers, directors, agents and members and the owners of the trial facility and the stock, for any loss, cost or expense including attorneys fees and costs, to which the CKC, its officers, directors, agents or members, the trial giving club, its officers, directors, agents and members and the owners of the facility and the stock, might be subject to as a result of any claim, suit, loss or damage caused in any way by any act or negligence on my part or on the part of any dog or dogs I have entered in or brought to the event. I acknowledge that while the CKC may provide sanctioning for this event, it does not have and does not exercise control over the conduct of the event or those present. I also agree to pay the full market value (\$200.00 for sheep and \$15.00 for ducks), of any livestock death resulting from my dog's actions, whether wilful or accidental, or in the case of injury to any livestock, resulting from the dog's actions, I agree to pay all veterinary fees up to the market value of the animal.

RULES

1. The Thunder Bay Cocker Spaniel Club, Tucker Creek Farm, organizers will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability in the event of an accident or misfortune, however caused, to either dogs, exhibitors or property. Dogs must be kept under control at all times, and must be kept on leash except when competing.
2. It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a Herding Trial held under these regulations is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Herding Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.
3. The CKC shall not be responsible to any member, person, partnership, club or corporation for any loss, damage or injury arising at or by reason of any herding trial held under any rules adopted by the CKC.
4. The listing fee for a dog not registered with the CKC is \$5.35 pre-trial (includes G.S.T.). A dog must be listed unless it has an individual registration number or an Event Registration Number (ERN) issued by the CKC. Only dogs eligible for registration with the CKC are eligible to compete at these Trials. Failure to obtain an ERN within 30 days of the event will result in any scores being cancelled by the CKC. Application for an ERN can be obtained from the CKC.
5. Only dogs entered in these trials (stockdogs excepted) will be allowed within the precincts of the trial.
6. The precincts of the trial will be from the road to the barn and from the house to and including the test/trial field.
7. Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up after their dogs.
8. Water will be available for dogs to cool off in
9. There is limited shade. There are no restaurants closer than 27 km from the site but food will be available on site. Exhibitors are advised to bring their own shade, crates, food etc.
10. Exhibitors must sign the waiver form before being allowed to compete.
11. Maximum time allowed for each run will be set by the course director and announced at the handlers' meeting. The course design for each class will be decided upon by the course Director, approved by the judge and posted one hour before the start of the trial.
12. Events will be held rain or shine. Dress for the weather.
13. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their dogs while they are on the trial grounds. All dogs must be kept on leash or in crates except when competing.
14. STOCK: Test/Trial runs will use 3-5 head of sheep/ducks.
