Sheep: 3-5 Head Limited Max Runs per day
(started may be woolies/advanced and open may be hair sheep/wool sheep crosses)

Ducks: 5 head Limited Max Runs per day
Cattle: 3-5 head Limited Max Runs per day

Order:

Start with Cattle Ducks will be run simultaneously with sheep, in the duck arena.
Classes: advanced, open, started, FEO (For Exhibition only) Junior Handler

Entries close one half hour before trial starts
Handlers meeting 7:45 a.m.

PATDsc (Sunday only) will precede Awards for regular trials

Check-In/Day of Show Entries: 7:30 a.m. (We request any substitutions/corrections must be made the night before if possible)!

Bitches in season run last – please notify trial secretary.

Stock dog Trial

Trial limit: Limited by number of runs judge is permitted to judge in a day.
A waiting list will be made in order of receipt if trial fills. Gate entries will be accepted at Sunday 1/2 hour prior to the trials.
Order of run will be determined day of trial. Bitches in season will run last.
Substitutions allowed. No refunds unless slot is filled by another dog.

Order for trial: Start with Cattle. Ducks will be run simultaneously after sheep have begun. (in each class: advanced/open/started/FEO/ Junior Handler)

Awards: High in Trial Aussie, High in Trial Other Breed, High Score Sheep, High Score Ducks, High Combined, High Combined non WTCH, Most Promising Started Aussie, Most Promising Started Other Breed, High Working Junior, High Open Working Junior Handler.

Directions to Show:

From Thunder Bay head south on Highway 61 towards the US border. We are located 1 km past the Neebing Roadhouse. We are the first driveway on the right hand side just past ReCool Recycling and across from DeBruins Nursery.

From the US border, heading north on Highway 61 towards the city of Thunder Bay we are approximately 25 miles from the border towards the city of Thunder Bay. The address is 3020 Highway 61 and are the last driveway outside the city limits. You will see the "Welcome to Thunder Bay" sign just after our driveway.

Please park along the driveway as it will be cleared out along the sides. We ask that you pick up after your dogs and put the bags in the garbage cans provided.

There will be either a luncheon or concession for the trials. BBQ, snacks and refreshments will be available for sale.

TBASCO is the Thunder Bay Australian Shepherd Club of Ontario, an affiliate club of ASCA (Australian Shepherd Club of America). TBASCO is an ALL-BREED/MIXED-BREED club, with groups planning events in Herding, Tracking, Agility, and Obedience. New members welcome.
